Current YMCA Child Care Families:

Participants are welcomed to attend camp during their normal afterschool hours from 12:00 pm to 6:00pm or for before school hours from 7:00am—9:00 am. Participants who need extra care will need to pay the following fees:

- Participants enrolled in Plan 1, Plan 1K and Plan 1KR are eligible to participate in day camp for \$50.00
- Participants enrolled in all other plans - Plan K, Plan 2, Plan KR and before school only—may attend day camp at an additional cost of \$75 per child per week.

Not a YMCA Child Care Family?

Your child may still participate in day camp at a special rate of \$100 per child per week.

Snack and Lunch:

Snacks and lunches are not provided during school breaks. Please be sure to pack your child an AM snack, lunch, and a PM snack. Snacks and lunch should be cold food items and should not include foods that contain any peanuts or peanut products.

In order to help ensure the safety of your child, parents/guardians must sign the attendance book when bringing children to the site and when picking them up. Only those people whose names appear on the Registration Form as authorized to pick up your child will be allowed to sign the child out after showing ID. While the YMCA does not ever expect child abuse or neglect to be a problem, our Staff is required by California State Law and licensing requirements to report immediately to the police or Child Protective Services any instance in which there is reason to suspect the occurrence of physical, sexual or emotional child abuse, child neglect or exploitation. If YMCA Staff believe that notifying a parent may place a child in the way of more serious harm, our Staff may not tell parents when the police or Child Protective Services have been called about possible child abuse, neglect or exploitation. The extent of Staff's communication with parents will depend on the recommendation of Child Protective Services after they intervene. Any willful destruction of property will be the responsibility of the participant's parent, guardian or representative. The YMCA is not responsible for lost or damaged personal belongings. Continued inappropriate behavior (including, but not limited to threatening, swearing, teasing, sexual harassment/intimidation) may result in suspension and/or expulsion from the program with no refund. Returned checks will be charged a fee of \$25. Fees and approved scholarships are due before the start date or child's attendance of the program. I have read and understand the terms and conditions related the YMCA Day Camp Program. I have shared appropriate information related to expected behavior with my child(ren). I agree to abide by the rules, terms and conditions as stated in this form.
